Zero waste in our delivery

Our reusable satchels can also hold a reusable water bottle and coffee mug for refreshment on the go.

All collected materials are segregated for onward recycling / reprocessing to make new products.

We are proud that our service ensures full recovery of all materials that have been previously discarded.
