To maintain a respectful, safe, and secure environment, please avoid wearing the following during your visit:



Hats, scarves, or head coverings (unless worn for religious reasons)



Outdoor clothing such as jackets, coats, hoodies



Torn or damaged clothing



Clothing with offensive, abusive, or inappropriate language or images



Steel-toe footwear or cycling/motorbike shoes



Smartwatches or wearable tech



See-through or overly revealing clothing



Non-prescription sunglasses



Metal hair accessories



Visible or exposed underwear



Very short skirts, dresses (unless worn with leggings), or Shorts shorter than mid-thigh length



Flip-flops, sliders, or boots that rise above the ankle



Crop tops or clothing that exposes the midriff, chest, or back

Footwear: Please wear sensible shoes. Open-toe styles are fine as long as they are secure and not flip-flops or sliders.
